The Multi-Agency Evaluation Study (MAES) is a collaborative effort among several federal and state agencies to gauge how well the field of environmental conflict resolution (ECR) is performing, and to better understand the key factors that contribute to success. The 3-year study builds on the cooperative development of a framework for measuring expected outcomes from ECR processes and important process ingredients. The Study's data base covers 52 cases and includes 523 responses to participant questionnaires. Initial findings will be presented and discussed.
