

- "Scenic & Recreational" St. Croix River (part of W&SRS)








St. Croix River Crossing Context

- Historic town (Stillwater, MN)
- Historic lift bridge








St. Croix River Crossing Context

BUT....

 Lift bridge has deteriorated & is overused – safety issues





• And Stillwater is congested



Key Issues

- <u>Lift bridge</u> is icon but would be removed for a new bridge under NPS "no proliferation policy"
- New bridge could:
 - ▶ induce growth, especially on WI side
 - impact undeveloped shoreline and endangered mussels
- New bridge with sufficient capacity:
 - might be out of scale with surroundings
 - presents connection challenges on both sides of River



Chronology

1950s - 1970s Bridge discussions begin

1980s MnDOT, WisDOT & FHWA begin working on

new bridge proposal

1990 Draft EIS developed

1995 Final EIS issued; NPS approves; ROD signed

1996 Sierra Club sues and wins; NPS reverses approval

1998 - 2000 Alternative bridge options proposed—and rejected

Agencies at impasse; USIECR engaged

Agreement reached



USIECR's Involvement

- Asked to intervene by FHWA/ WI (Summer 2001)
- Conducted conflict assessment (Fall 2001)
 - Separate decision-making for old and new bridges
 - ▶ Use collaborative approach including all stakeholders
- DOI changed requirements; States re-started negotiations (Summer 2002)

USIECR Involvement (Continued)

Facilitated selection of mediators (Fall 2002)

Helped convene stakeholders (Spring 2003)

Oversaw collaborative stakeholder process (2003-2006)



Mediation Process

- Separate lift bridge and new bridge processes, initially
- Processes include all key stakeholders (27)
 - ▶ Federal agencies (7)
 - ► State agencies (6)
 - ▶ Local governments and agencies (4)
 - ▶ Private advocacy groups (10)
- Working toward consensus solution



Progress & Successes

Planning for \$5M lift bridge rehabilitation (short term)
 completed in 2003

• Inclusive stakeholder group meets for 3 years

- Consensus on preferred alternative reached
- Stakeholders meet & reach agreement (July 17, 2006)
